Job Description

The Audio & Video Technician is responsible for operating, testing and troubleshooting audio and video equipment for worship services.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure proper pre-service setup for microphones, speakers, screen, recording equipment, connecting wires and cables, sound and mixing boards for Sunday service.
- Set up and operate sound equipment.
- Perform proper line check.
- Perform proper sound check; includes gain settings, monitor mixes, proper volume settings, and eq/mixing process.
- Uploading audio and video to sermon podcast, website and church YouTube channel.
- Test and resolve equipment issues.
- Diagnose and correct media system problems.

Qualifications and Skills Required:

- Experience with livestream technology and mixing audio successfully in the live environment.
- Able to work in team settings and take directions.
- Have good communication skills.
- Ability to think quickly and react/trouble shoot properly in the moment.
